Skating Rink

The rink's grand opening event was a great success, with over a hundred residents coming out to take advantage of the opportunity to skate on the new rink for the very first time. It was an engaging event, with a variety of outdoor games, a fire pit to gather around and warm up, and lots of smiles all-around! MLA Kaycee Madu attended and brought donuts and cookies to round out our event.

This rink would not have been possible without the amazing support we received from our sponsors, particularly Brookfield Residential, who granted us access to the land as well as funds. Did you know? The ice rink is a massive financial commitment by the League because the City of Edmonton does not pay directly for rinks in communities. Our League voted to spend over \$16 000 in order to make this rink happen for our community because residents told us this was a priority for them. We hired the company Outdoor Ice to build and maintain our rink this year. Each year we want to have a rink, we will require significant financial and time commitments. Please remember that it takes people power to ensure that we can continue to build and maintain a rink in the future, so we need community members to help us out!

Right now, we are in need of volunteers to sign up for turning lights on and off. The time commitment is minimal and it's super simple! We will provide you with instructions and a handy-dandy video that shows you just how easy it is to do it. Other ways to help us out:

- **Invest in a community membership before using the rink.** One of the posted rules is that all skaters at the rink have a valid membership with skate tags. The funds from membership sales directly benefit the League as it helps pay for things like rink maintenance. Membership is only \$20, and the [benefits](#) quickly offset the cost.
- **Volunteer your time on a more consistent basis by being on our Board of Directors.** Our Board organises exciting community events and offerings (like the rink), but it takes human power to make this happen! We're looking for more people to join our efforts, and we're fun to boot, too!

As the provincial election draws near and candidates are out door-knocking, please consider asking individuals about their and their party's plans to ensure that a school in our neighbourhood is built as soon as possible. **With candidates looking to secure votes, we need to make sure they know how important a school is to our neighbourhood.**

The paper petition that hundreds of residents signed is on its way to being presented in the Legislature. As we learned, it is quite the process to bring forward a citizen petition but we are making it happen!

Our League is in ongoing contact with Brookfield, the developer of the school and sports field site, and they have committed to making the preparation of the site a priority. We appreciate Brookfield's support in this matter because the land needs to be as close to serviced and "shovel-ready" as possible before the government will move on committing to a school.
