


01 DOG PARK FOLLOW-UP

The Edgemont Community League wants to express our disappointment that Edgemont was not chosen by the City of Edmonton to receive a pop-up dog park despite being named in initial press releases and after residents were asked to complete surveys to decide on a location. The League fully supported a dog park and offered to consult with the City regarding locations. However, no communication to the League was made about barriers to a dog park in Edgemont at any time during the process.

Please know that we have reached out to City officials numerous times in the last month since the decision was made. We learned that neither of the sites proposed for our community were seemingly viable from the start according to reasoning provided by the City in our recent communication. It is our impression that the process was rushed, and the City did not look into the land ownership (Developer vs City) and proximity of suggested sites to natural areas before releasing their list of proposed communities and public survey.

We will continue to advocate for a pop-up dog park in the community next year, if the program runs again, because we know how important this amenity would be to our residents.




